
Regular Meeting of Council for October 11, 2022

Election Reminders


- If you haven't received your Voting Letter in the mail yet, please contact Legislative Services to make sure the correct information for you is on the Voters' List.

Short Term Accommodations

Council received an update on Short Term Accommodations work to date. Staff will be conducting additional community consultation in early 2023, as well as proposing updates to the Noise and Property Standards By-laws to promote more effective enforcement.

Other Council Items

- Council approved the request from the Legion for the Remembrance Day parade, subject to County approval over the County Road portions of the route.
- Council approved the Zoning and Official Plan amendments to support two severance applications which were initially heard at the September 27th, 2022, meeting.
- Council passed a by-law to assume responsibility for a completed portion of Cherrywood Parkway.
- A public meeting was held for an application to sever a lot on Mill Street to develop a single-detached and semi-detached dwelling.
