

# Town of Greater Napanee Council Highlights

Regular Meeting of Council for April 5, 2022

## Tomlinson Asphalt Plant and Concrete Plant

Council has denied the zoning by-law amendment request from RW Tomlinson to permit a Permanent Asphalt Plant at the quarry on County Road 2 on the basis that it does not appear to be in the best interest of the community. Council also passed a motion to advise the Provincial government that Greater Napanee is an unwilling host for a permanent asphalt plant at this specific location.

## Red Tree Developments Inc - 265/267 Newburgh Road

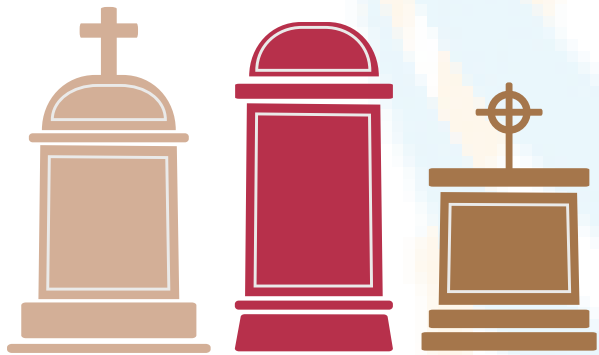
Council approved the zoning by-law amendment by Red Tree Developments Inc for 265/267 Newburgh Road. This by-law will allow for the development of four buildings consisting of 4-unit dwellings and two single detached units for a total of 18 residential units. The intended market for these units is for seniors housing.

## Voluntary Termination of Cemetery Licensed Operator #3284767 (Roblin Cemetery)



As of April 30, 2022, the cemetery lands, operating funds, all books, records notes, etc. for the Roblin Cemetery will be transferred to the Town of Greater Napanee. 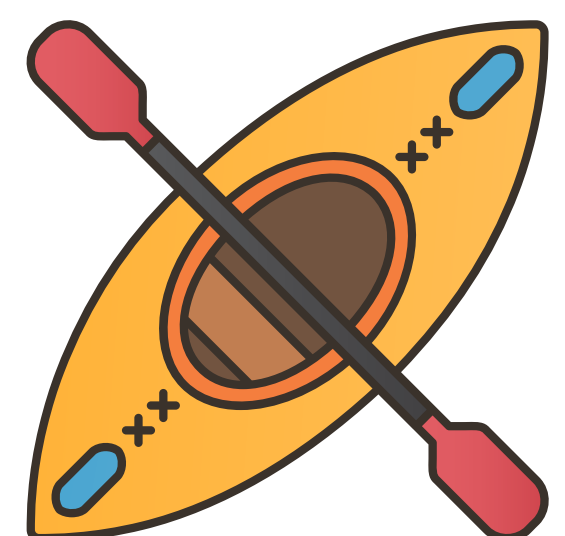
## Restricted Acts of Council after Nomination Day

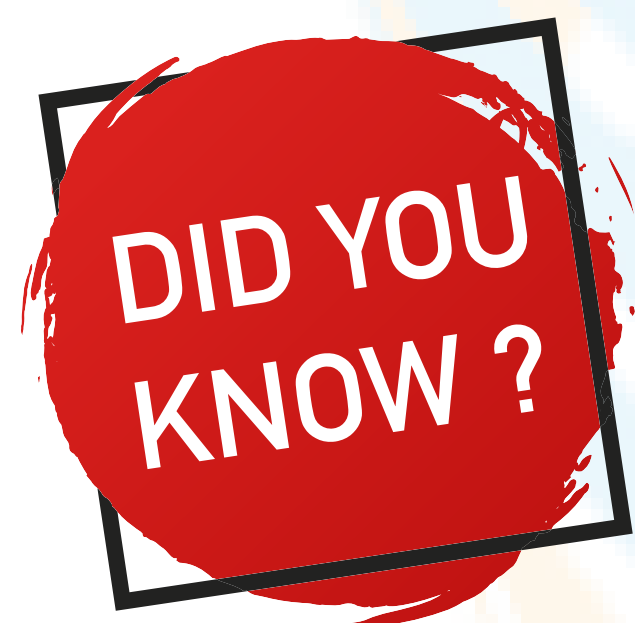

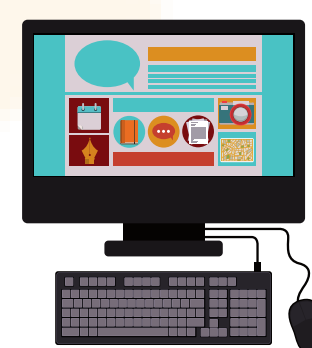
Council has awarded the contract for the preparation and delivery of a Recreation Master Plan to Sierra Planning and Management for the sum of \$60,000 including HST.

Council endorsed the amendments to the Policy for Use of Corporate Resources during the Municipal Election Campaign Period as presented in the [staff report](#) available on the agenda for the April 5, 2022, Regular Meeting of Council.

Council has supported the proposed 50m tall self-supporting telecommunications tower, identified as Xplornet ON8247, that will be installed in Selby. The new location is approximately 670m south of the originally proposed location.

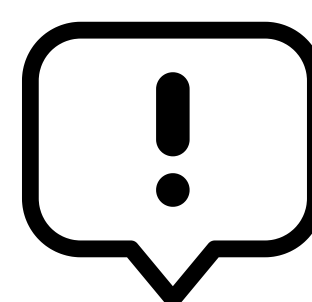
