Regular Meeting of Council for September 13, 2022

Waste Diversion Committee Update

Council endorsed the recommendations in the first report and presentation from the Waste Diversion Committee to:

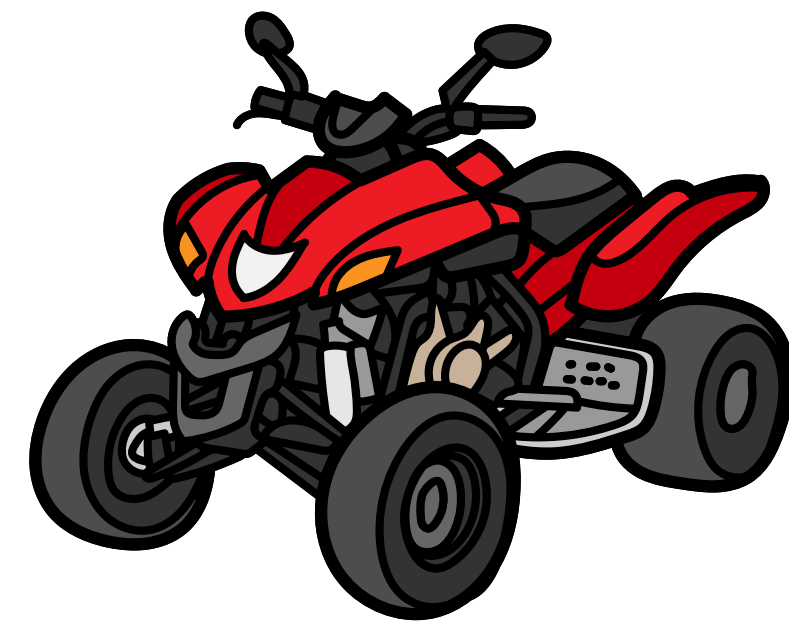
- Include enhanced Household Hazardous Waste disposal in the 2023 budget discussions;
- Approve a three-month pilot program for waste diversion events; and
- Launch public education and outreach efforts to improve waste diversion efforts.



ATVs in Urban Areas

Council approved a by-law to permit ATV use on some urban streets within Greater Napanee. A corresponding by-law will also need to be passed by the County of Lennox and Addington. ATV users are reminded that they still cannot:

- Operate an ATV without a helmet, insurance, or drivers license.
- Operate on municipal roads between 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.
- Operate on municipal roads with more than one passenger

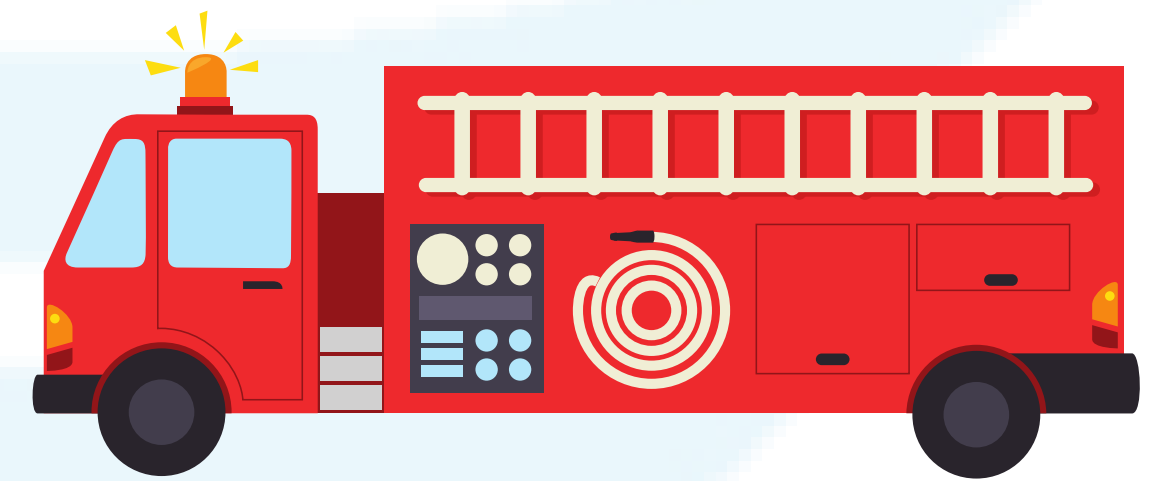


Development Charges By-law

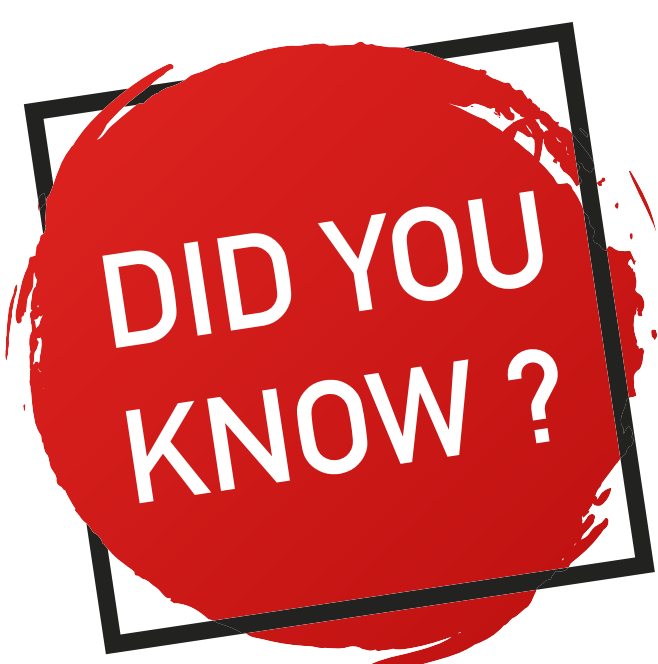
Council approved a new Development Charges By-law, which is required to be reviewed and updated every five years. Development charges help municipalities recover the costs for new infrastructure to support growth through development fees rather than fully funding these costs through property taxes and utility bills.

Staff Update

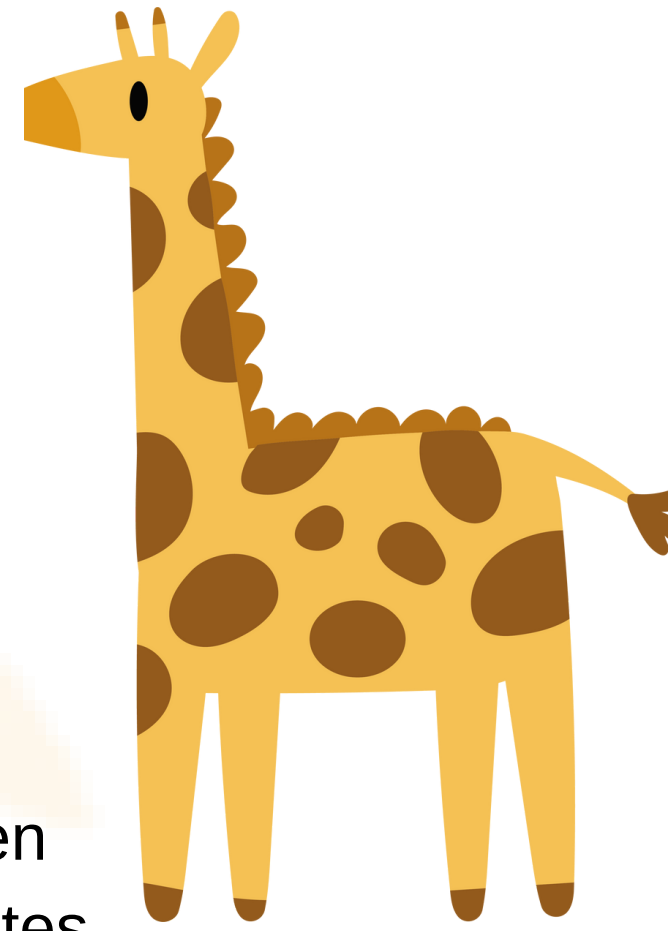
What's to Come

Other Council Items

- Council approved Zoning Amendment applications at 124 Old Hamburg Road (Limestone Ridge Subdivision) and 21 Pleasant Drive (Lennox Fence)
- Council directed staff to bring back an Exotic Animals By-law in the next term
- Council received information about the discontinuation of the Hometown Market
- Council adopted a by-law to regulate the operation of Cemeteries under the control of the Town
- Council adopted a new Council Remuneration by-law, in accordance with the direction given at the August 9 meeting. The Council remuneration by-law maintains the existing salary rates, but changes salary increases to match those given to non-union staff rather than to annual inflation.

In person voter registration is available at the Community & Corporate Services office at 41 Dundas Street W during office hours. If you live at, own, or rent property within Greater Napanee you can register to vote and cast your ballot up until the closing of polls on Monday, October 24.

An all-candidate's forum will be hosted by the Chamber of Commerce on October 6, 2022 at the Strathcona Paper Centre. Doors open at 6 p.m. The Town of Greater Napanee will also have election staff in attendance to offer a voter registration booth.

Please remember to bring your ID (proof of identity and qualifying address within Greater Napanee) in order to be registered to vote.

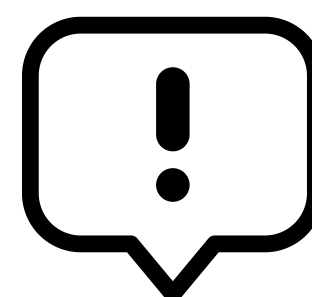
