The Park is located on Victoria Street and is home to our Rotary Splash Pad and brand-new accessible Rotary Playground! Our campers will get to spend the summer enjoying our weekly themes, activities and games as well as enjoying time splashing and swinging on the new equipment.

Rain Days and/or Extreme Heat Advisories: We are hoping for perfect weather but that might not always be the case. On rainy and extreme heat advisory days campers will catch a bus at the Park and head to the North Fredricksburgh Hall (1178 County Rd 8, Napanee, ON K7R 3K7), home of our fall & winter camp programs. The Campers will spend the day in the hall carrying out their fun filled plans indoors. Parents will be notified if camp is relocated. Parents will be required to pick-up at the North Fredricksburgh Hall at the end of the day.

Ways we are working to Improve:

New this summer we will have a Head Leader position at Camp. The Head Leader will be your main point of contact and will help keep you connected to camp activities. Have a question about your child's day or wondering what's taking place the following week? The Head Leader can help!

What to Bring to Camp:

LUNCH/SNACKS: Children are reminded to bring nutritious, NUT FREE lunch and snacks as well as plenty of drinks to camp every day. Refillable drinking containers are recommended as well. There is a water cooler on site. We are unable to refrigerate or reheat lunches. Every Friday BBQ lunches are offered; please send extra snacks and drinks for your child.

SUNSCREEN: SLIP on a shirt, SLAP on a hat, and SLOP on some sunscreen. Please send your child with labeled sunscreen. Staff is not responsible to apply sunscreen to each and every camper, although a buddy system is in place and time is allotted to apply regularly.

CLOTHING: NEW this year - It is mandatory that children wear their camp shirt every day of the week so that the group is identifiable. Please send your child with a swimsuit, towel and running shoes every day. Open toe shoes are not recommended! Once again we will have additional camp T-shirts available to purchase this year.

VALUABLES: Day Camp Staff are not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged belongings. Please ensure that your child's name is labeled on everything and do not send valuable items to camp. Electronics are not permitted at camp including cell phones, DVD players, iPods, tablets, DS etc.

Busing/Trips:

All bussing, admissions and activity costs are covered in your weekly registration fees. If you are not there by the specified time, buses will leave without you. You will need to find alternate arrangements for your child that day. All events are subject to change. Every attempt will be made to reschedule trips. Parents must give consent for trips as indicated on the registration form. Any excursions that involve swimming will be under the supervision of qualified lifeguards.
