



## **LABOURER/OPERATOR/NIGHT PATROL**

Working in the Infrastructure Services Department in the area of Public Works, this position will report to the Manager of Public Works and/or Lead Hand.

This is a full-time position, 40 hours per week, night shift from November to April and day shift from April to November, with call back duties as required.

### **Responsibilities Include:**

- Become familiar with road system and maintain records of inspection for roads, signage and lighting
- Working independently on straight nights (November-April) to assess road conditions, plow where necessary using appropriate equipment and call in staff as required
- Responsible for the operation of heavy equipment required in road maintenance
- Seasonal labourer duties required to maintain road allowance, storm sewers and sidewalks
- Grass cutting and trimming and forestry type work (tree cutting, brushing, land clearing)
