

'GREY' BOX

Paper Products

All paper products should be placed in a clean *untied* grocery bag. This keeps the paper dry and from blowing away.

Newspaper	Telephone Books
White Paper	Catalogues
Coloured Paper	Soft Cover Books
Colour Flyers	Magazines
Hard Cover Books (with cover and binding removed)	
Envelopes (window can be left in)	

WE DO NOT ACCEPT GIFT WRAP.

Do not include: Polycoat materials such as milk cartons, juice cartons and Tetra-Pak juice boxes.

Boxboard

Flatten and bundle or place inside a grocery bag or another box.

Cereal/Cracker Boxes	Paper Towel Tubes
Frozen Food Boxes	Drink Trays
Egg Cartons	Greeting Cards

Corrugated Cardboard

Remove staples and tape. Flatten and bundle no bigger than 36"x24"x8". There is a 6 bundle limit per collection. Place beside your 'grey' box.

Do not include: wax coated boxes or soiled pizza boxes.

BLUE BOX

Place **clean** food & beverage containers **loosely** in the blue box. **Do not include:** Styrofoam – it should be placed in the garbage as it cannot be recycled.

Plastic

Look for the following symbols:



Polycoat

Rinse and flatten milk cartons, juice cartons and Tetra-Pak juice boxes.

Glass Bottles and Jars

Place clean glass bottles and jars loosely inside the blue box.

Do not include: broken glass, window panes, mirrors, light bulbs, ceramics or drinking glasses.

Aluminum and Steel Cans

Place clean metal food and beverage cans, aluminum trays and foil loosely inside the blue box. Metal lids can be placed inside a can and pinched shut. Labels do not need to be removed.

Plastic Bags

Place all *clean* bags into an *empty* bag and tie shut.

Grocery Bags	Frozen Vegetable Bags
Milk Bags/Pouches	Newspaper Sleeves

Do not include: cereal/cracker box liners, plastic food wrap, zipper storage bags, diapers, meat/bacon packaging, "crinkly" outer packaging (e.g. Pasta wrappers), pet food bags or bubble wrap.
