Water St. Reconstruction – Town of Greater Napanee ON

Our company, **Gordon Barr Ltd.** has been engaged by the Town of Greater Napanee to perform reconstruction work (including watermain and selected sanitary and storm sewer replacements) on **Water St. between Centre St. and Richard St.** and on **Robinson St. between Mill St. and Baker St.** As part of our work, you will be receiving new water and sanitary services from the Town mains to your front property line, where they will be connected to the existing service extensions on your property. **It is proposed that this construction will commence on April 6th, 2020 and be complete by the end of September 2020, with major underground work expected to be completed by the end of July.** To permit the work, single-block closures of Water St. to through traffic will take place, beginning at Centre St. and progressing west to Richard St. Similarly on Robinson St. (*please see staging diagrams on the reverse side of this page*)

We will take every precaution to minimize interruptions to the normal function of your household / business, however we hope you can appreciate that due to the nature of the work some degree of disruption will be un-avoidable. During the road closures, local traffic will be permitted wherever possible to maximize access to your property, however at certain times (ie: when excavations are taking place directly in front of your property) **access to your driveway may be limited or unavailable for brief periods of time.** In these instances we would kindly request you to make arrangements with a neighbor to park in their driveway that day / night, or alternatively please feel free to contact our site supervisor Jason Davis at (613) 561-4283, whom can provide guidance on where suitable parking may be for that night. Outside of the road closures, at minimum single lane access for emergency vehicle and local traffic will maintained within project limits.

You may continue to place garbage at the front of your property on collection day as you normally would - we will move it to other location(s) for pick-up on an as-required basis.

Please note our company also complies with the provisions outlined in the “Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act”. We encourage residents with any mobility limitations to notify us prior to construction start-up so we can fully address any specific inquiries or concerns you may have.

Should you have any further inquiries pertaining to this project, please call our office during business hours at (613) 542-4922 x110. It is appreciated if inquiries are directed to our office as opposed to the Town in order that we can provide response and/or rectify any issues as quickly as possible.

Please note that in accordance with project specifications, we have hired the services of a professional inspection agency **OZA Inspections** to perform a pre-construction survey. As such, in the coming days you may expect to receive correspondence directly from OZA prior to their inspection of your property. Please note that due to the current COVID-19 pandemic, inspections will be limited to exterior areas only.

Re: The COVID-19 Coronavirus, please note that Gordon Barr Ltd. is undertaking all work in strict accordance with guidelines and regulations pertaining to physical distancing, hygiene, the use of health-related PPE, etc. that have been governmentally mandated and endorsed through the various union affiliations applicable to our operation. All personnel are provided with updated information as it becomes available and our policies and procedure continue to evolve as the pandemic and the associated guidelines and regulations evolve. As an example, last week portable handwashing and sanitizing stations were provided on all our sites. Over the duration of our contract no personal items will be placed on private property and there should be no reason for any close physical contact with our personnel. As such, no elevated risks of contracting the Coronavirus on account of our presence in the street should be expected. Along with the client the Town of Napanee, we are hoping the project can be completed in it's entirety with no delays or interruptions, however in light of the current uncertainties that change every day the possibility of COVID-19 related delays due to factors beyond our control cannot be completely ruled out.
