Recognition pay shall be based on a first (1st) class firefighters' rate, it shall form part of the base pay and shall be paid to all bargaining unit members on their anniversary dates in respect of all forms of pay, for all purposes including pensionable earnings, save and except STD, LTD, WSIB and Pregnancy and Parental Leave.
