Regular Session of Council for April 11, 2023

Backyard Poultry

Council reviewed community feedback requesting a by-law change to allow urban backyard poultry. Council decided to defer the matter until fall of 2023 due to concerns around high transmission rates of avian flu at this time and potential increased safety risks. The topic will be revisited at one of the meetings in the fall. Residents are welcome to continue to submit feedback to the Clerk's department on this subject in the interim.

Services Fees By-law

2022 Year to Date Financial Operational Results


Council received a <u>report</u> on the 2022 year end operating budget variance. The 2022 capital budget variance report will be presented at the April 25th meeting.

Noise By-law

Council reviewed the community feedback received to date on the proposed noise by-law changes. Staff will be bringing a revised draft by-law to a future meeting for Council's consideration.

Town Participation in Giveaway Day

The Town of Greater Napanee will be participating in this years Giveaway Day by opening the doors of Town Hall (124 John Street) and 12 Market Square. The main floor of each building will be open, for residents to look through office furniture deemed as surplus.

Raw Water Reservoir Liner Replacement Update

Council awarded Layfield Canada Ltd. as the sole supplier and installer of a new raw water reservoir liner for the Napanee Water Treatment System. An additional \$63,040 will be used from utilities capital reserves to purchase an upgraded liner. The capital project was previously approved by Council as part of the 2023 Utilities Budget. Once completed the raw water reservoir will hold 18,000 m3 of raw water. The project is to be completed in the summer of 2023.
