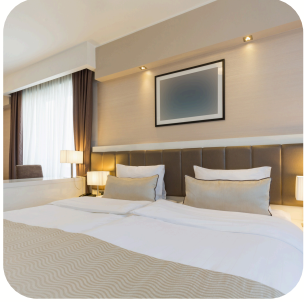


Municipal Accommodation Tax Draft Policy and Tourism Entity



Council awarded the RFP to the Bay of Quinte Regional Marketing Board. Staff were directed to bring back a Service Agreement between the Bay of Quinte Regional Marketing Board and the Corporation of the Town of Greater Napanee for approval. Staff were also directed to bring back the Use of Municipal Accommodation Tax Reserve Funds Policy at the next available meeting.

Draft Municipal Alcohol Policy



Council directed staff to conduct a review of the legal, insurance, and legislative implications. Staff will bring a final draft of the policy back for consideration to Council.

Regulation Changes to Tailgate Event Permits



Council directed staff to investigate and draft a by-law and Municipal Alcohol Policy amendment to create an enabling framework for third-party "bring-your-own event" permits to be reported to the next term of Council in Q1 of 2027.

Confirmation of Advisory Committee Workplans



Council endorsed the 2026 advisory committee workplans, including the Market Square and Waste Diversion plans as presented, select Arts and Heritage Committee items aligned with their mandates (with unbudgeted Heritage items deferred to the 2027 budget), and confirmed no changes to the Recreation Advisory Committee mandate for the remainder of the Council term.



Hydroster - Municipal Support Resolution Request

Council supported the “Quinte Energy Storage Centre” project and, if it receives an IESO contract, directed staff to require a Holding (“H”) Symbol on unused lands through the Site Plan Agreement to preserve them for agricultural use unless and until otherwise approved through a subsequent planning process.



Land Sale By-Law Amendment (Enhanced Transparency)

Council directed staff to amend the Land Sale By-law to allow public reporting of limited details related to rejected land purchase offers. The new reporting requirement will be done on a go forward and not retroactive basis.



By-law Enforcement Standards Policy Review

Council directed that the draft revisions to the By-law Enforcement Standards Policy be brought back to a future meeting for adoption after consideration of the Legislative Service Levels. Council endorsed the proposed communication strategy for the policy.
