
Backyard Poultry By-law Update

Council received an <u>update</u> on a Backyard Poultry By-law. Council confirmed that given ongoing concerns around avian flu, Council does not wish to permit backyard poultry in urban areas.

Council received a <u>report</u> outlining options for filling a Council vacancy. Council directed staff to proceed with Option 4 of holding a by-election to fill the vacant Councillor seat.
