Bay of Quinte Regional Marketing Board Presentation

Council heard a presentation from Dug Stevenson at the Bay of Quinte Regional Marketing Board on an overview of the 2025-2026 fiscal year. The presentation outlined a project calendar, what Greater Napanee funding helps achieve, a new tourism page for Greater Napanee, and various marketing campaigns.



Warming/Cooling Centre Activation Policy

Council approved the Warming/Cooling Centre Activation Policy for immediate implementation. The Policy establishes a clear and consistent framework for determining when municipally owned facilities may be opened to the public during periods of extreme cold, extreme heat, and prolonged power outages.



Encampment Protocol Update

Council received an update on the Town's Encampment Protocol. The report established expectations for the upcoming summer, outlined case volumes, and provided updates on mapping, the budget related to encampments, and service levels.



Activity Reports

Council received activity reports from each Town department. The activity reports provided a summary of updates from each department relating to areas such as E11 tickets, upcoming events, hirings, the municipal election, staff training, fire calls, and road work.
