# **Train Station Facility Use**

Council authorized staff to enter into a Lease Agreement for \$1.00 per year with Morningstar Mission for the use of the West section of the Train Station, located at 301 John Street, for the Morningstar Furniture Program.

## **Richmond Mobile Home Park Expansion**

Council approved the Official Plan Amendment and Zoning By-Law amendment for the Richmond Mobile Home Park Expansion subject to two conditions as stated in the <u>staff report.</u>



#### **Procedure By-law Update**

Council considered a by-law to replace By-law 2008-58, being a by-law to govern the calling, place and proceedings of Council and committees of Council and conduct of its members. However, Council elected not to pass a by-law update prior to the end of this term.

## **Road Closure Application**


