
Centre Street Boat Launch Engagement Project

Napanee River Navigational Buoys




Council has approved staff's proposal to grant the Town ownership of 28 additional buoys along the Napanee River which were previously owned and maintained by Quinte Conservation. The Town will control the timing of the maintenance of the buoys and will ensure any required maintenance, buoy relocation or replacement is done prior to the opening of walleye season which is a peak usage period for the river. Major By-law Review Projects for 2022


Council has requested a number of by-law and policy updates for 2022. Some of these updates will require public notice and/or a community engagement proponent. Staff will be working on updating a list of by-laws and policies presented in the <u>Major By-law Review Projects for 2022 report</u> available on the February 8, 2022, Council agenda. Major projects requiring updates include, but are not limited to, the ATV By-law, the Short-Term Accommodation By-law and Sidewalk Encroachments.

Fire Master Plan Community Survey


