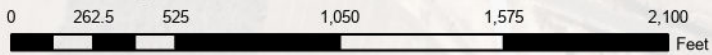
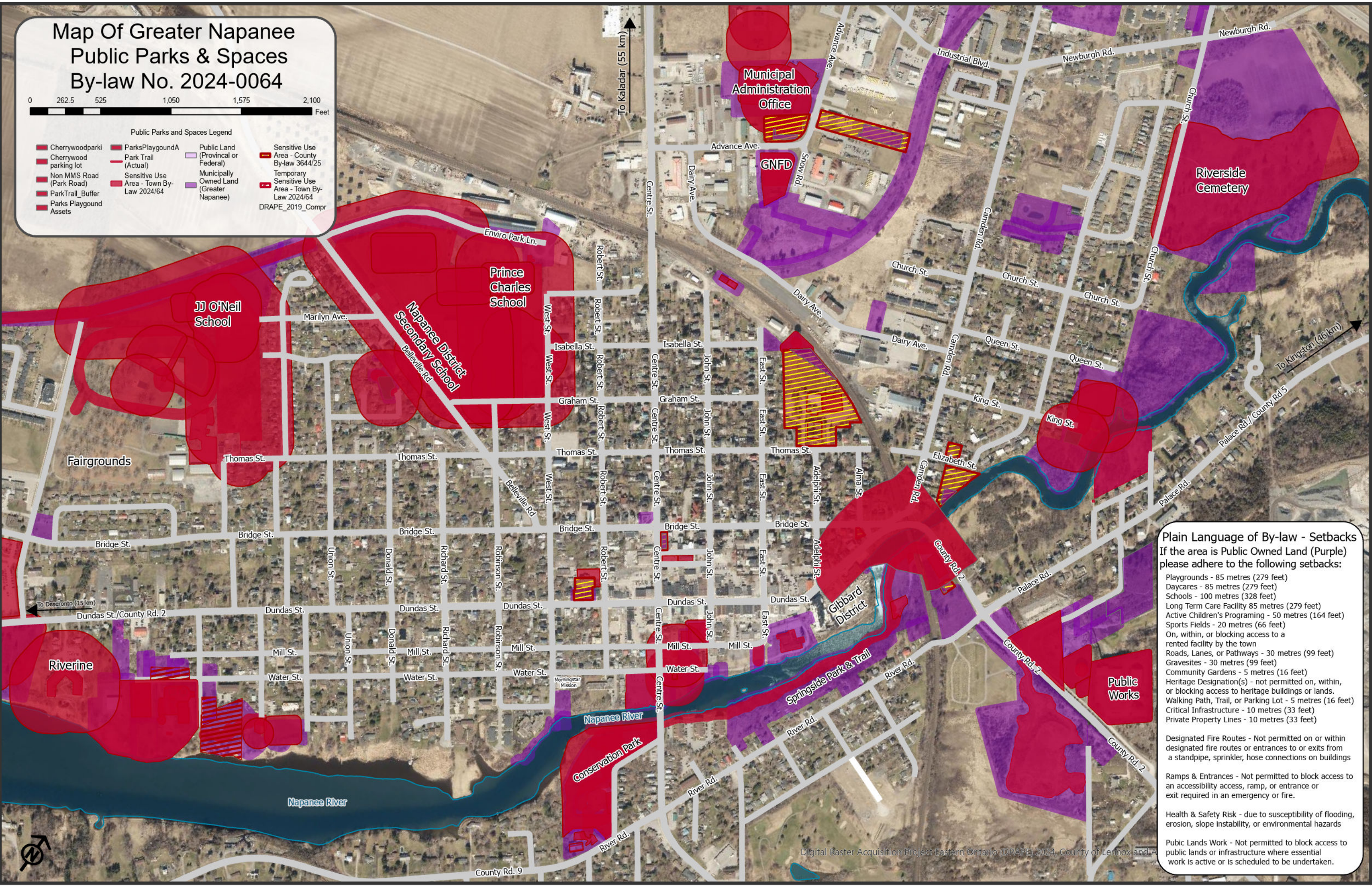

Plain Language of By-law - Setbacks
If the area is Public Owned Land (Purple)
please adhere to the following setbacks:

- Playgrounds - 85 metres (279 feet)
- Daycares - 85 metres (279 feet)
- Schools - 100 metres (328 feet)
- Long Term Care Facility 85 metres (279 feet)
- Active Children's Programming - 50 metres (164 feet)
- Sports Fields - 20 metres (66 feet)
- On, within, or blocking access to a rented facility by the town
- Roads, Lanes, or Pathways - 30 metres (99 feet)
- Gravesites - 30 metres (99 feet)
- Community Gardens - 5 metres (16 feet)
- Heritage Designation(s) - not permitted on, within, or blocking access to heritage buildings or lands.
- Walking Path, Trail, or Parking Lot - 5 metres (16 feet)
- Critical Infrastructure - 10 metres (33 feet)
- Private Property Lines - 10 metres (33 feet)

Designated Fire Routes - Not permitted on or within designated fire routes or entrances to or exits from a standpipe, sprinkler, hose connections on buildings

Ramps & Entrances - Not permitted to block access to an accessibility access, ramp, or entrance or exit required in an emergency or fire.

Health & Safety Risk - due to susceptibility of flooding, erosion, slope instability, or environmental hazards

Public Lands Work - Not permitted to block access to public lands or infrastructure where essential work is active or is scheduled to be undertaken.
