Regular Meeting of Council for February 28, 2023

Service Fees By-law Review

Council reviewed a list of proposed changes to the <u>service fees by-law</u>. Staff will be bringing a revised report to the March 14th meeting based on discussion at the meeting, which will include additional recreation fees and deferring any type of boat launch membership fee until a more fulsome boat launch strategy has been developed.

Upcoming Community Consultations

Council received information regarding three upcoming community consultations, which will be hosted through Let's Talk Greater Napanee.

- A review of the Noise By-law, to obtain feedback from residents on the types of noise restrictions they do and do not want to see put in place.
- A review of the Parking By-law, which will include feedback from residents on how the current parking rules impact them. This feedback will also be used to guide future long-term planning.
- A review of the municipal website, to determine how we can better support our residents through our online services.

Drinking Water Quality Management System Policy

The Town of Greater Napanee is committed to supplying a safe, consistent, drinking water supply and to complying with all applicable regulatory requirements. We strive to achieve these goals through the implementation of a management system comprised of documentation that demonstrates risk-based treatment process evaluation, staff competency, open communications, workplace safety, and appropriate emergency response measures.


