Heavy Fleet Funding Requirements

Council received a pre-budget <u>presentation</u> on heavy fleet funding requirements. The presentation highlighted existing heavy fleet, the life cycle of items, and the investment required to replace equipment.

Proposed Licensing By-law for Mobile Food and Beverage Vendors


