Regular Meeting of Council for July 23, 2024

# **Certificate of Recognition - Bill and Marina Kosmopoulos**

Mayor Richardson presented Bill and Marina Kosmopoulos with a certificate of recognition. Bill and Marina will be retiring at the end of July as the owners of La Pizzeria for the last 42 years. Congratulations and we wish them all the best in their retirement.

## **Parking By-law Review**

Council received a <u>report</u> for information on the Parking By-law Review. Staff were directed to bring forward a draft by-law that includes changes based on public feedback collected during community consultation for consideration at a future meeting.

## **Plow Trucks Purchase Report**

Council discussed a proposal for a multi-year approach to capital budgeting in the context of pre-approving a plow truck for the 2025 budget. Council requested a report back to the August 27th meeting with more information on a long-term capital budget approach and other anticipated financial needs. Council confirmed the approval for staff to purchase one plow truck, as included in the 2024 capital budget, and deferred a decision regarding the purchase of a second truck.

## **Town Hall Interior Update**

Council directed staff to suspend any interior updates on the main level of Town Hall. Staff were asked to bring back a report that provides additional information on potential plans for the main level of Town Hall to the August 27th meeting.



# **What's Happening in Our Municipal Departments:**

## **Community & Corporate Services**

Areas of discussion included the South Fredericksburgh playground replacement work that will begin the week of July 29th, new Boat Launch signage installed at Centre Street, ongoing work on this year's Culture Day event, hall rental usage and revenue from January to July, and CCTV replacement that has commenced and is expected to be complete by July 26th. The complete <u>Activity Report</u> is available on the July 23rd agenda.

### **Financial Services**

Areas of discussion included the implementation of HRIS MyWay that is underway, implementation of PSD Citywide Asset Manager that is underway, an updated investment strategy that will be brought to Council in Q3, and the accounts payable listing for the period of June 14th-July 15th. #### **Fire Department**

Areas of discussion included public education events attended by the department, inspections completed, the door-to-door smoke and carbon monoxide alarm campaign that has started, an early earthquake warning system that has been installed at Station 1, and a GIS dashboard that is being finalized. #### **Growth & Development Services**

Areas of discussion included updates on the Atura Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) Phase I, J.J. O'Neill Expansion, 158 Heritage Park Drive Apartment, Klaver Masonry Workshop/Warehouse, Hilton Hotel, Goodyear Expansion, Village Green Long Term Care Facility, and L&A Hospital Long Term Care Facility. #### **Infrastructure Services**

Areas of discussion included the first cut of roadside mowing that has been completed throughout the municipality, a retro reflectivity program on all roadside regulatory signs that has begun, and a new point of sale system for accepting debit payments that is now active at the South Fredericksburgh Waste Disposal Site. ## Legislative Services
