Follow Up to May 11 Special Meeting

In response to the public feedback provided at the May 11 Special Meeting regarding the former CN rail line lying north of the 401, Council passed a resolution to defer any further discussions on the potential sale of this land until such time as:

- Sufficient community and stakeholder consultation has been held; and
- A good faith effort has been made to find an alternative route for a trail, as was discussed during the May 11 meeting.

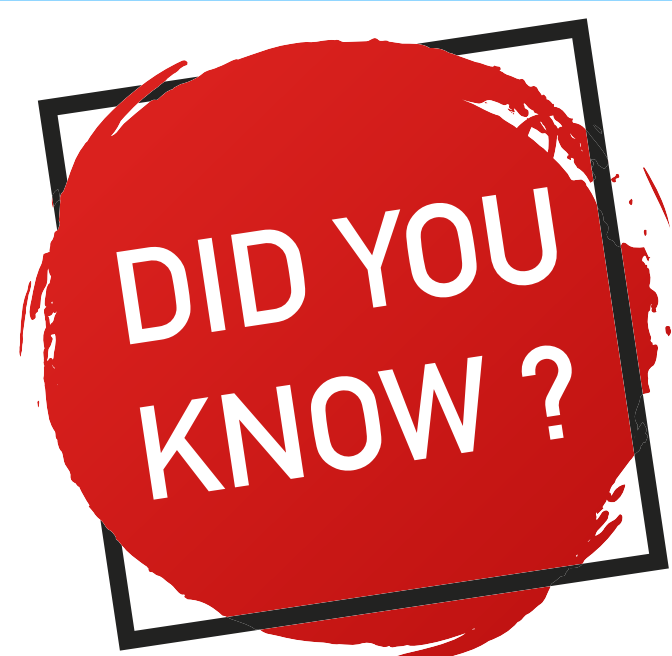
This work will be assigned to a new ad hoc trails committee. The new committee will also be tasked with studying the feasibility of a trail and making recommendations about developing a Cataraqui Trail connection and the in-town portion of the former rail line as a trail. The membership of this committee will be finalized at the June 6 meeting of Council.

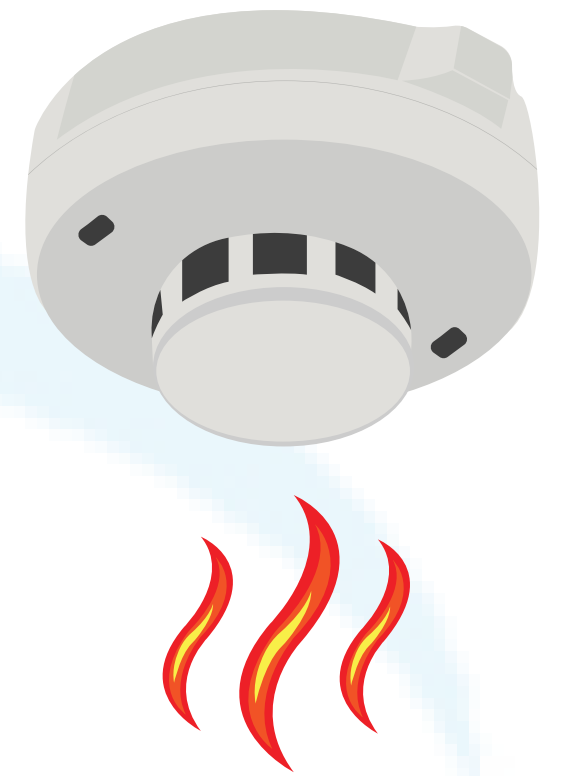


Financial Services

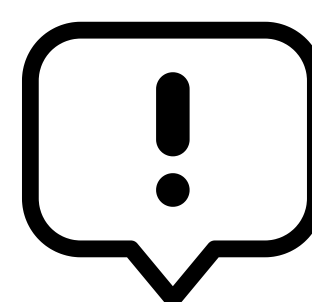
