



[Recommendation to Pause Parking By-Law Review](#)

Council directed staff to pause work on the Parking By-law update until it can be done with the support of a comprehensive parking needs assessment. Staff are recommending that the review work that has been done to date be referred to the next term of Council and that a major review of the Parking By-law be done if and when an urban parking study is conducted as part of the Zoning By-law update that will follow the adoption of the updated Official Plan.



[Lighting Recycling Promotion and Education - Community Collaboration Pilot Agreement](#)

Council endorsed the Product Care Association of Canada – Lighting Recycling Promotion and Education Community Collaboration Pilot Agreement and authorized the Mayor and Clerk to execute the agreement on behalf of the Town. The agreement will provide \$5,000 to the Town for promotion of its Household Hazardous Waste Day event on September 12, 2026, which will include lighting recycling.



[Use of Municipal Accommodation Tax Reserve Funds Policy](#)

Council adopted the Use of Municipal Accommodation Tax Reserve Funds Policy. The Policy will ensure that revenue collected through the Municipal Accommodation Tax program is directed to support and manage tourism development, including infrastructure, services and initiatives, and to address tourism related opportunities and issues facing the community.
