

Town of Greater Napanee Council Highlights

Special Session of Council for March 30, 2023

Adoption of the 2023 Operating and Capital Budgets

The Council of the Town of Greater Napanee intends to adopt the 2023 Operating and Capital Budgets at a Regular Session on Tuesday, April 25, 2023, at 7:00 p.m. The meeting is scheduled to be held at Town Hall (124 John Street, Napanee) and will be livestreamed via the Town's YouTube channel.

The 2023 proposed total operating and capital tax levy is \$14,096,140 or an increase to the current tax base of 2.89% over 2022.

The budget presentation is available under the Agenda for the March 30, 2023, Special Meeting of Council.

Proposed Increase to Waste Collection Fees

As part of its 2023 operating budget, the Town of Greater Napanee intends to increase some of the service fees within Garbage By-law No. 06-14, as amended, effective May 1, 2023, as follows:

- The fee for individual bag tags to be increased from \$3.00 to \$4.00
- The fee for additional bags of domestic waste delivered to the waste disposal site to be increased from \$5.00 or a bag tag, plus \$2.00 to be \$6.00 or a bag tag, plus \$2.00
- The fee for residential bulky waste to be increased from \$0.40/cubic foot with a minimum charge of \$12.00 to be \$0.45/cubic foot with a minimum charge of \$15.00

In addition, Council intends to pass a by-law to issue a special tax levy on each property that is eligible to receive curbside garbage collection, pro-rated for half of the year for 2023. As part of this change, each property will be levied the equivalent of \$4 per tag for 25 weeks on their property taxes. Each property that is levied the \$100.00 waste collection fee will have 25 bag tags mailed to them, with the intention of covering the period from June 1 to December 31. Any additional tags required can be purchased at the increased rate of \$4.00 per tag.

Council will consider the proposed by-law at its Regular Session on Tuesday, April 25, 2023, at 7:00 p.m.

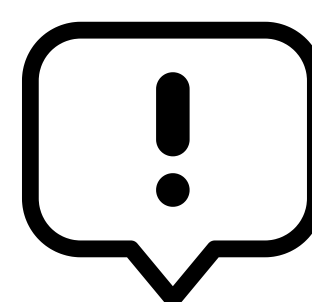
